LANGLEY SCHOOL ESTATE

Langley is a friendly, co-educational senior school that dates back to 1910. Our pupils have the opportunity, support and space they need to fulfil their potential both in the classroom and outdoors.

We boast a large site, situated in Grade 1 listed grounds, originally designed by Capability Brown. The Main House is home to boys boarding, Ballroom, Dining Hall, boarding common rooms and offices, whilst the teaching areas and girls boarding are located across the site. With 110 acres, space is not a problem. We have an impressive modern 550 seated performance hall, a more intimate black box drama studio and a high-spec ICT suite, which boarding pupils can access in the evenings and weekends. There are 4 music practice rooms which are all sound proofed. The academic subjects are taught in accessible purpose built modern blocks around the site.


Within the 110-acre parkland estate, we have 6 rugby pitches, 4 football pitches, 3 cricket squares and a high tech gym with a dedicated strength and conditioning area.

The Sixth Form Centre is the newest building: it has its own café, ICT room, resource and seminar rooms and break out areas for independent study.

Langley School has long been renowned for its support of STEM subjects. Not only does the school have state-of-the-art equipment and facilities, but a range of activities that are innovative, engaging and inspire pupils to follow these subjects to the highest levels.

Centre of Excellence in Design and Technology

Langley School was one of the first schools in the country to receive the Design Mark, which rewards schools for the excellence of their design teaching. Young designers and engineers are encouraged to aim high, through use of specialist equipment, allowing them to access a wide range of STEM activities. The pupils' learning is also supported with regular visits to industry. The school has had an impressive success rate, with pupils being awarded prestigious Arkwright Scholarships and many more have gone onto study design or engineering based degree courses at some of the best universities.

Innovative and Engaging Science

Science is one of the corner stones of the Langley curriculum. With a team of dedicated, specialist teachers and technicians housed in a purpose built science block, we are able to offer an exciting, engaging and innovative programme that suits all budding scientists from Years 6 to the Upper Sixth.

Langley Mathematics

Developing a sound competency in the above fields is not possible without a thorough understanding of mathematics. Mathematics is one of Langley School's core subjects. As with all subjects at Langley, only qualified subject specialists teach the subject whatever year you are in. In addition to the curricular lessons, pupils are encouraged to look at mathematics beyond the curriculum and UK Mathematics Challenges are regularly hosted at Langley to allow pupils to compete at various ages and levels.



CREATIVE ARTS

Langley boasts a wealth of departments that fall under the Creative Arts, notably Fine Art, Drama, Music and Photography. All are headed by specialist teaching staff with educational and industry experience. Each department is resourced to a high standard and the school was awarded Artsmark Gold in recognition of the absolute commitment to embedding arts and cultural experiences at the very heart of pupils' learning. We believe that involvement in Creative Arts is a life-enhancing experience that equips our pupils with essential transferrable skills and therefore, it should be available to everyone.

Fine Art

We teach our pupils a wealth of specialist skills and knowledge in the younger years to embed a love of learning. Drawing, painting, sculpture and printmaking are all explored in depth, using a variety of media. We refer to a range of artists, both historical and contemporary, to inform our practice. Our aim is to stretch and challenge everyone, which includes our art scholars, and to develop and refine their work through constructive feedback and group discussions. We run trips to exhibitions for all year groups and we are developing a programme of exhibitions to showcase the high quality outcomes that are produced in our studios.

Music

Music is a highly regarded subject here at Langley, providing an inclusive and accessible environment for our pupils to experience music of all genres. There are plenty of opportunities to perform in and outside of school, including Norwich Cathedral, with our choir ensemble, orchestra, Dixie band and Music Scholars' events, a thread of music is woven throughout life at school. We offer a full range of first class orchestral instrumental lessons and weekly rehearsals for instrumental and vocal ensembles.

Drama

Our Drama department is a thriving hub of creativity that offers our pupils the chance to participate in every aspect of live performance; there are a myriad of opportunities in this dynamic sphere. School



productions, junior plays, scholar events and academic teaching, all take place in the enviable surroundings of our drama studio and main auditorium. Whether on stage or behind the scenes, pupils can learn a wide range of stage crafts as part of their studies or as an extracurricular activity. There are regular full-scale productions that are always extremely popular and well supported by the school community. The Drama department is a place where everybody can build character; on the stage and within themselves.

Photography

Photography pupils achieve beyond their expectations. They enjoy a fast-paced and challenging course that is highly practical and covers demanding theory, semiotics and critical analysis of the visual world in which we live.



SPORTING EXCELLENCE

Sport is an important part of life at Langley. Comprising 110 acres of Norfolk countryside and grounds, we have fantastic sports facilities and staff for teaching theory and practice in the UK. We offer our pupils excellent modern sporting facilities in a beautiful and historic setting.

Langley proudly offers pupils the opportunity to enrol in our Football and Rugby academies. We are one of the only schools in the UK to offer a dedicated programme of sports working with key sporting partners including Norwich City Football Club, Leicester Tigers Rugby Academy and the British Canoeing Talent Pathway Programme. We also partner with clubs to develop and extend sporting talent.

Langley is a school where individual talents can be nurtured, developed and encouraged. Many pupils have excelled in recent years and their physical literacy and Long Term Athlete Development (LTAD) are well managed to maximise their potential in their chosen sports.

Traditional team sports are also available throughout the year and our inclusive environment ensures that all ages and abilities have an opportunity to take part in the sport and most of all, have fun.

There are a range of scholarships for outstanding young sportsmen and women.













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SIXTH FORM

Life for students at Langley's Sixth Form encompasses hard work, responsibility, opportunities and lots of fun. We inspire and encourage our students so they make the most of their talents and fulfil their individual potential. We offer excellent support with university applications from an experienced team and our commitment to the students is lifelong.

Our course subjects offer something for everyone and our small class sizes ensure that students get the support network they need from our experienced tutors.

Our purpose built Sixth Form and Performance Hall gives students their independence and freedom away from the main school, whilst still being part of the Langley community. 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BOARDING

Separate purpose-built accommodation is available for boys and girls. They have excellent facilities, including newly refurbished common rooms, kitchens, laundry and study areas. We make every effort to ensure Langley feels like a home away from home for our pupils and cater for the needs of our boarding community to provide them with a safe, friendly and supportive environment.

All of the team are experienced EAL teachers, supported by learning mentors and a resident teacher from mainland China.

After helping new students settle happily into school life, the team then design tailored support programmes that will help them fulfil their academic potential. All their progress is closely monitored and flexible so that it is always right for them, throughout their time at Langley.

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APPLYING TO LANGLEY SCHOOL

Our admissions process is designed to ensure that all of our parents and pupils know that by joining Langley, they are making the best choice for their education and wellbeing.

Applications are welcome at any time, however, the deadline for receipt of applications is the end of the Autumn Term in the year prior to the year of entry.

Most pupils join at:

- Year 6 (aged 10+)
- Year 7 (aged 11+)
- Year 9 (aged 13+)
- Lower Sixth (aged 16+) for Sixth Form

Four steps to joining Langley, a non-selective school:

- 1. Complete and submit the application form along with registration fee
- 2. We will then obtain a reference from the pupil's present school
- **3.** Taster day including a CAT style test. Being a Growth Mindset school, we believe that effort and application are the keys to success. The more information we have, the more we can support the learning.
